

## UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

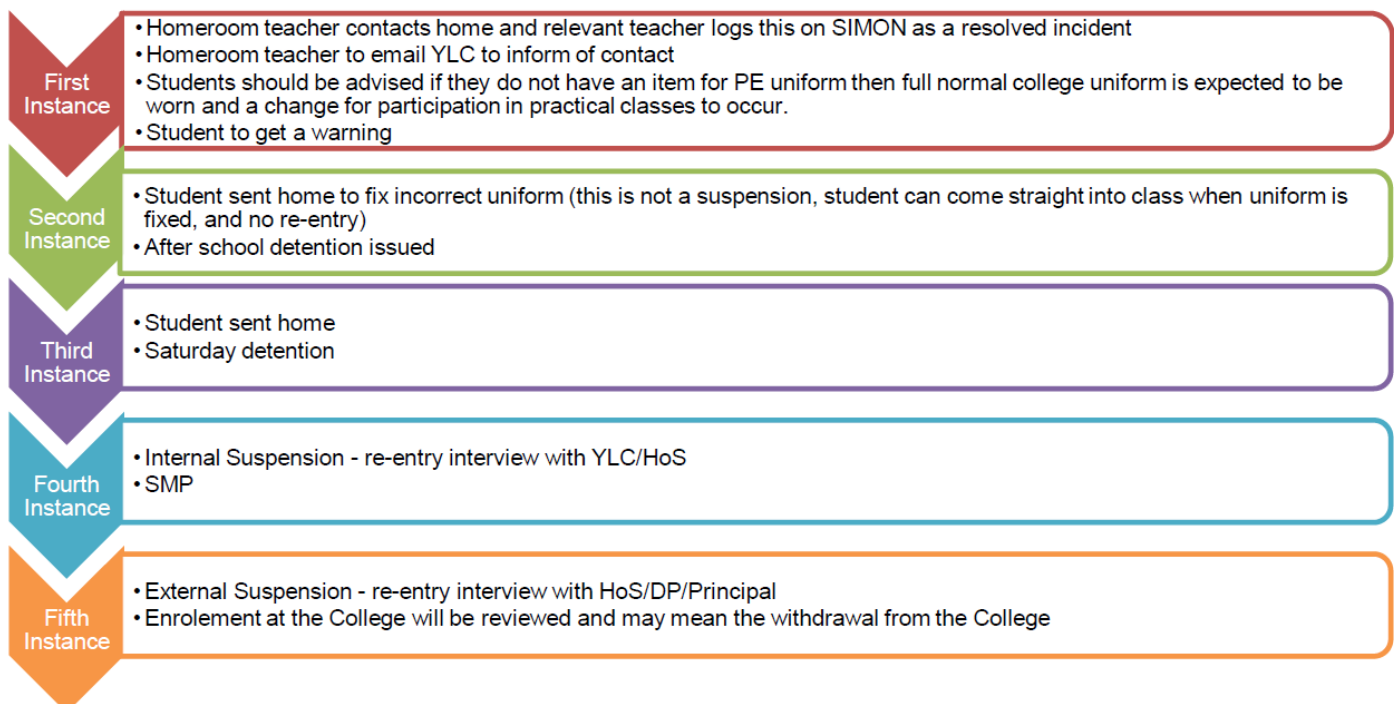
Students are representatives of the College from the moment they put on any part of the uniform and are therefore expected to maintain the standard of the College in the following manner:

- girls' summer dress and winter skirt length must be the appropriate length
- winter uniform is to be worn in the Pentecost and Assumption Terms
- students who ride a bicycle to school must wear an approved safety helmet
- a range of College hats/caps are available to be worn. The College recommends the wearing of a hat/cap during recesses, lunchtimes, in PE classes and for ACS, particularly in the Lenten and Advent Terms
- belts are to be plain black leather only and only to be worn with the College long pants and/or shorts
- Hair: Students' hair should be clean, well-groomed and off the face. Students are not permitted to dye their hair to unnatural colours nor are they permitted to have excessively shaven hair or bizarre hairstyles.
- The College reserves the right to adjudicate on both the colour and style of a student's hair and, if necessary, request that alterations be made. For both girls and boys, hair longer than shoulder length should be pinned up and away from the face or tied back using an elastic hair-tie, plain blue or black headband or a plain blue or yellow ribbon. No other form of decoration should be worn in the hair. In practical classes, hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back for health and safety reasons.
- Boys: Boys are to be clean-shaven at all times.
- Jewellery permitted to be worn by students include plain and small gold or silver studs or sleepers (one in each ear). No nose, eyebrow, chin, lip and tongue studs are permitted. Tape or band aids are not permitted to cover any piercings. A wristwatch and a small plain crucifix are also permitted.
- Tattoos are not approved by the College. Students with tattoos are expected to ensure that they are fully covered and cannot be seen at all times.
- Shoes must be black leather lace up shoes and worn unless a medical note from a registered Podiatrist is presented
- Sport shoes must support the foot's arch and heel. It has been proven that wearing inappropriate footwear that lacks this support will not only cause immediate discomfort but also long term orthopaedic problems.

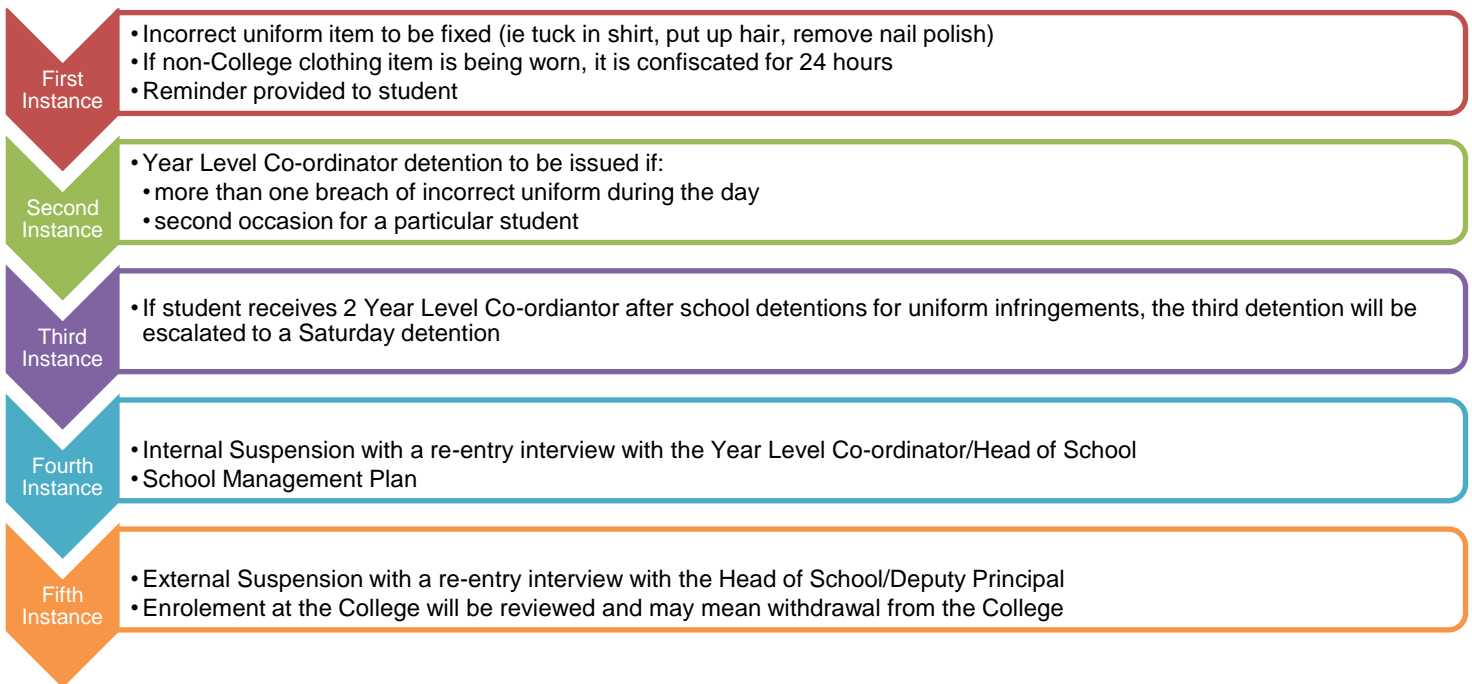
Students who fail to comply with these uniform and grooming regulations will incur a detention. The College reserves the right to send students home for a breach of these regulations.

### Uniform Procedures

If a student is wearing the incorrect uniform that is *unable to be rectified* at the College (i.e. wrong pants, shirt, shoes, socks, hair colour etc), the following procedures will be followed:



If a student is wearing the incorrect uniform that *can be rectified* at College (i.e. untucked shirt, tie undone, wearing a hoodie, wearing a beanie, wearing headphones, wearing of nail polish, hair is down, etc) the following procedures will be followed:



In cases where students are out of uniform, it is not able to be rectified and have brought a note from a parent/guardian, the relevant Year Level Co-ordinator (YLC) may use their discretion and make a special arrangement with the parents/guardian and student. This will be recorded on SIMON by the relevant YLC. If this is a regular occurrence from a particular student, an immediate meeting will be arranged with the parents/guardians.

### Girls

- College dress
- White socks
- Black leather lace up shoes (No T-Bars)

### Boys

- Long or short grey socks
- Grey Shorts or trousers
- Summer short sleeved open neck shirt with new College logo (will not be tucked in, see Figure A) or short sleeved button up shirt with new College logo to be tucked in and worn with College tie (see Figure B)
- Black leather lace up shoes
- No undergarments showing

### Girls

- Navy or black tights
- Black leather lace up shoes (No T-Bars)
- Long Sleeve white button up shirt with new College logo
- College tie with new College logo
- College jumper with new College logo

### Boys

- Grey College trousers
- Grey long or short socks
- Long sleeved white button up shirt with new College logo OR short sleeved white button up shirt with College logo (must be tucked in)
- College tie with new College logo
- College jumper with new College logo

*Scarf – must be blue and is to match the blue of the College uniform*
