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### Applying for an exemption ([vicroads.com.vic.gov.au](http://vicroads.com.vic.gov.au))

Applications for an exemption from the Peer Passenger Restriction can be made on hardship grounds.

Exemptions may only be granted by VicRoads if the nature of the person's employment, essential activities or family circumstances is such that compliance with the restrictions would impose undue hardship to the person or the person's family. In considering an exemption, VicRoads must also have regard to the likely effect of the exemption on safe, efficient and equitable road use in Victoria.

If an exemption is issued, it will be made conditional and include restrictions. This information will be sent to the probationary driver in writing and must be carried by the driver at all times when carrying more than one peer passenger.

VicRoads may cancel an exemption if the probationary driver's license is cancelled or suspended. Applications will only be considered where the completed exemption form [PDF 71KB, 4pp] and supporting documentation has been provided. Applications must be sent to:
