Engage

STUDENTS are proactive and take responsibility for engaging with their learning.

TEACHERS design and deliver a high quality education through both online and non-digital platforms.

Connect

STUDENTS connect with their teachers and peers through Homeroom check-ins and online classes.

TEACHERS use SIMON and Microsoft TEAMS to connect with their students through a combination of online and self-directed offline learning activities.

PARENTS connect with their child's Homeroom teacher and subject teachers by email and via PAM.



Support

STUDENTS seek support from their Homeroom teacher and subject teachers using SIMON, Microsoft TEAMS and email.

TEACHERS support students by delivering lessons online using a combination of online and non-digital learning activities. Teachers will be available to students online between 8.30am to 4.30pm.

PARENTS support their child by helping to set up a remote learning environment, establishing routines, communicating with their child and managing screen time.
