# Fees for 2023

WRFL Registration fee \$20, is being charged this year, in 2022 it was not charged and subsidised by the Western Bulldogs due to Covid restrictions affecting AFL.

Truganina Thunder Member fees \$210 first child, \$200 second child, \$190 third child.

The GameDay processing fee is taken from the fees and balance is transferred to the club.

#### **Uniforms**

Existing members uniforms can continue to be worn in 2023. New uniforms can be purchased from the club starting in February 2023. Training Tops are compulsory for each member \$40 each Home shorts are compulsory for each member \$35 each Away shorts required for U12 & U14s ONLY \$35 each Socks are compulsory for each member \$15 each Game Day playing jumpers are owned by the Club and provided to players on game days.
