WHO WE ARE

NEiTA is the longest running, community-based awards program to recognise teaching excellence in Australia and New Zealand. It acknowledges the talented, committed, and caring educators who demonstrate the personal qualities, skills, and passion that help shape the lives of future generations in a fast-changing world.

Over the last 28 years, NEiTA has received around 40,000 nominations for excellent and inspirational teachers and more than 1,100 teachers have received the award. Through the awards program, the NEiTA Foundation has presented more than \$1.2 million in professional development grants, prizes and endowments.

THE PRIZE

Award winners receive a professional development grant of up to \$10,000 to further their career. They will be honoured in a virtual awards ceremony, and be invited to meet and network with the other recipients and NEiTA Alumni.
