OUR COLLEGE PATRON: ARCHBISHOP THOMAS CARR

Thomas Carr, the second Catholic Archbishop of Melbourne (1886–1917), was both a visionary and a builder – of places, of opportunity and of communities that would endure.

While Melbourne's St Patrick's Cathedral stands as his most visible legacy, his deeper impact lies in the many communities he established and strengthened across Victoria. Among these was the parish of Werribee, founded in 1906 – an enduring expression of his commitment to growth, connection and the flourishing of local communities.

Today, Thomas Carr College reflects this same spirit. As a contemporary Catholic secondary school, it brings together academic rigour, pastoral care and professional growth in a learning environment shaped by diversity, innovation and connection. 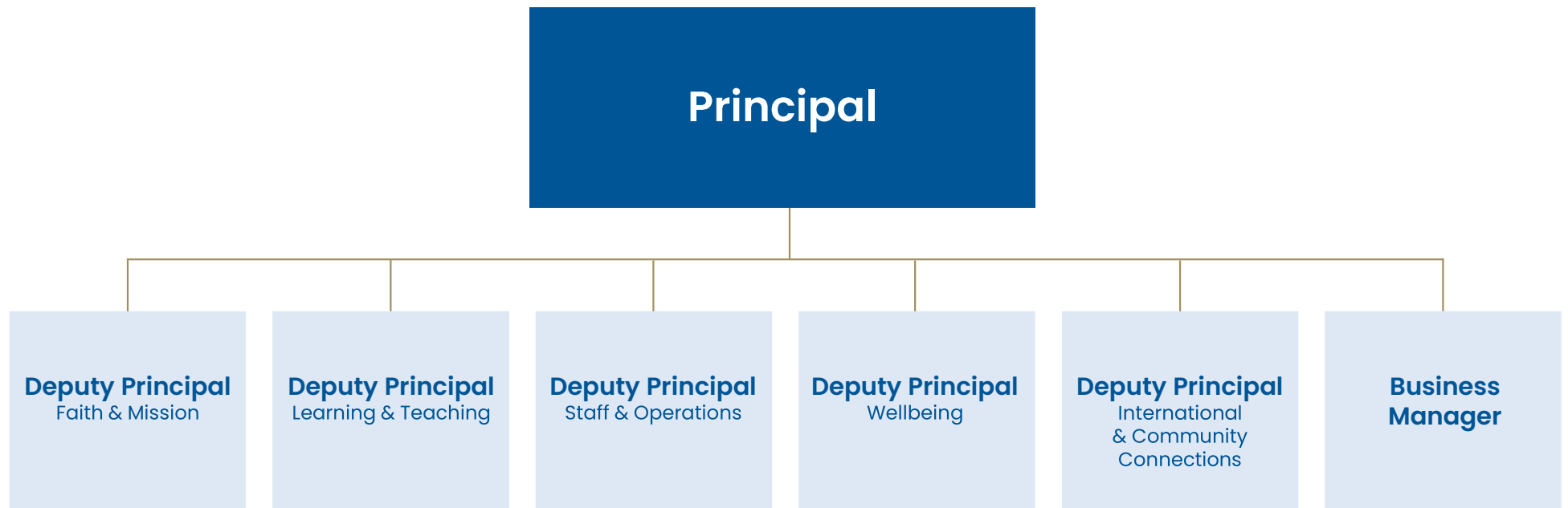

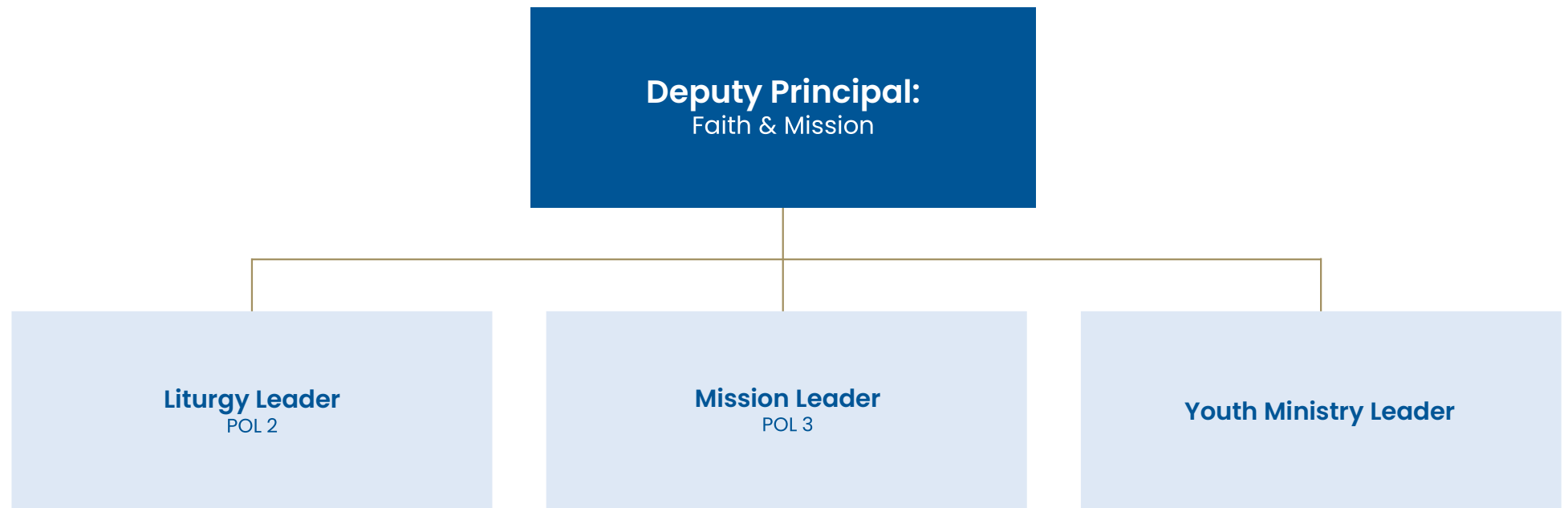
ORGANISATION CHART

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications should include:

INTERVIEW PROCESS

Shortlisted applicants will be contacted during the week prior to interviews and provided with:

- interview date and time
- venue details
- panel composition
- any relevant presentation requirements

Interviews will commence from the week beginning **Monday 14 September 2026**.

As a Catholic learning community, all applicants will be invited to lead the panel in a short prayer or reflection connected to faith leadership and the College motto, *They Will Shine*.

Applicants for Positions of Leadership classified as POL 3 and above will also be asked to prepare a short presentation aligned to the portfolio responsibilities of the role.

Further details will be provided upon invitation to interview.

FLEXIBLE & INCLUSIVE LEADERSHIP PATHWAYS

Thomas Carr College recognises that leadership can take many forms and values flexibility in supporting staff to contribute meaningfully across different stages of their professional journey.

Consideration will be given to both full-time and part-time applicants (0.8 FTE and above), where practical to the requirements of the role.

Applications are welcomed from:

- current staff
- contracted staff
- staff currently on maternity or approved leave
- educators seeking progression into leadership pathways

At Thomas Carr College, leadership is viewed not simply as a title, but as the capacity to influence culture, empower others and contribute positively to community.

APPOINTMENT PROCESS

All appointments will be confirmed by the Principal in consultation with the Panel Chair.

Successful applicants will be contacted directly regarding their appointment and next steps relating to contract arrangements and commencement.

At Thomas Carr College, recruitment is approached with professionalism, transparency and respect for all applicants. Internal candidates will receive feedback through direct conversation, while external applicants will be notified via email, with feedback available upon request.

Leadership appointments will be communicated to the broader College community once all positions within each POL category have been finalised.
